Audition Prep & Transitioning from Theater to Screen Acting

- How to personalize your prep from the authentic places within you, then apply it to on-camera work (using a technique designed to help theater-trained actors make the transition to the fast paced demands of film & TV).
- Practice our technique to get out of your head, trust your gut, and expand your emotional range from a truthful place. Learn how these techniques apply to script analysis and on-camera performance.

Saturday, July 26th

Drills + Co-Star vs Guest Star Audition Practice

- You will practice innovative acting drills to address actors' specific on camera "-isms".
- How to nail the "co-star" - the first types of auditions actors see in their careers.
- Guest Star & Lead Role audition practice.
- Closeups On-Camera: Nuanced cinematic acting.

Sunday, July 27th

Self-Tapes, Casting Workshops, & Group Coaching

- Hear from working NYC actors on what they needed to begin their careers (*Includes discussion on headshots & resumes, getting agents & managers & booking roles*).
- Perfecting the "Selftape" - the self-directed submissions most auditions now require of actors. How to help your students master this before graduation.
- Perform your work in an Industry Workshop with a NYC Casting Associate, incorporate direction, and discuss the current reality of the casting process your students will navigate.
